Miracles are Kingdom Power

House of the Lord February 7, 2016

Mark 1:21-28 (NAS)

They *went into Capernaum; and immediately on the Sabbath He entered the synagogue and *began* to teach.

Verses 16-20 Yeshua calls His first disciples (learners – students). In Luke's account we find the baptism of our Lord, the temptation by satan, His appearance in the synagogue at Nazareth, then the parallel of this encounter.

²² They were amazed at His teaching; for He was teaching them as *one* having authority, and not as the scribes.

Our Lord taught with the authority of One who is one with the Word of Truth. Many people are missing out on the best part of their New Covenant life, for they keep waiting for something from somewhere else to come.

Luke 17:21 (NKJV)

nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you."

As a Believer, the Kingdom of God has taken residence within your recreated human spirit.

This is a portion of the revelation of:

Philippians 2:12 (NAS)

So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your salvation with fear and trembling;

A companion to an Old Covenant truth.

Isaiah 12:3 (NAS)
Therefore you will joyously draw water
From the springs of salvation.

But Pastor, I don't know how!

It is a matter of developing that third eye of the spirit within you.

Salvation, in all 5 arenas is in you. The Kingdom way of being and doing is in your spirit, you have the mind of The Anointed Redeemer in you. (1 Cor. 2:16)

The secret of success, authority, ruling and reigning, lie in drawing out of what God has deposited in you.

By way of example, wealth secrets of the Kingdom:

In Luke 5:17 the power of The Lord was present to heal, but none were being healed among the elders, they were too religious, when some came in faith, they got their reward.

Now look at wealth, "God has strengthened your hand to gain wealth" Deut. 8:18

Luke 5:1-7 (NAS)

Now it happened that while the crowd was pressing around Him and listening to the word of God, He was standing by the lake of Gennesaret; ² and He saw two boats lying at the edge of the lake; but the fishermen had gotten out of them and were washing their nets. ³ And He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little way from the land. And He sat down and *began* teaching the people from the boat. ⁴ When He had finished speaking, He said to Simon, "Put out into the deep water and let down your nets for a catch." ⁵ Simon answered and said, "Master, we worked hard all night and caught nothing, but I will do as You say *and* let down the nets." ⁶ When they had done this, they enclosed a great quantity of fish, and their nets *began* to break; ⁷ so they signaled to their partners in the other boat for them to come and help them. And they came and filled both of the boats, so that they began to sink.

- 1. Peter gave his boat over for Kingdom use.
- 2. He did what The Lord said
- 3. He didn't run to the mailbox looking for a check
- 4. The Lord brought wealth through Peter's hand
- Are you engaging Kingdom in your labors/giving –

The demon cried out through the man. The religious teachers of the law, were amazed, astonished, astounded, that there was more to the Text than they had discovered. They taught from outside The Word, Messiah taught from within The Word.

Even the demons know the difference, that's why they were at ease, at church.

²⁴ saying, "What business do we have with each other, Jesus of Nazareth? Have You come to destroy us? I know who You are—the Holy One of God!"

The demon recognized a different dimension of life and authority had shown up. The demon knew of his eventual end, he just did not know if his time was up or not.

²³ Just then there was a man in their synagogue with an unclean spirit; and he cried out,

Demons believe and tremble at the presence of The Anointing. They recognized a divine representative.

 $^{\rm 25}$ And Jesus rebuked him, saying, "Be quiet, and come out of him!"

The Master took control of the situation, and light ruled over darkness.

²⁶ Throwing him into convulsions, the unclean spirit cried out with a loud voice and came out of him.

The demon tried to gain an advantage by making a show in "the natural realm", but power is in the super-natural realm. Messiah would not let the devil announce Him, and neither would Paul. (Acts 16:17)

²⁷ They were all amazed, so that they debated among themselves, saying, "What is this? A new teaching with authority! He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey Him."

The Elders, teachers and "representatives of the Word" were shocked when they came face to face with the life, power and authority of The Word they "thought" they knew.

A sign of His personage. A wonder of the power of The Word. A miracle of triumph over darkness.

The Word is living and life giving. Kingdom rule works where you live and work.
