

# Rest Part 2

House of the Lord

Sunday, July 27, 2014

There is a place of rest, called there.

Psalm 91:1

The Believer who takes up residence,  
In the secret place of The Most High,  
Shall abide under the shadow of The Almighty.

Secret place, Holy place, the Throne of God.

Ephesians 2:4-6 (NAS)

But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, <sup>5</sup> even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), <sup>6</sup> and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus,

A place of rest, seated at the Mercy Seat!

Job 36:11

If they obey and serve Him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasure.

Psalm 1:1-3 (NAS)

How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked,  
Nor stand in the path of sinners,  
Nor sit in the seat of scoffers!

<sup>2</sup> But his delight is in the law of the Lord,  
And in His law he meditates day and night.

<sup>3</sup> He will be like a tree *firmly* planted by streams of water,  
Which yields its fruit in its season  
And its leaf does not wither;  
And in whatever he does, he prospers.

Does this sound like rest, or what?

Psalm 9:9 (NKJV)  
The Lord also will be a refuge for the oppressed,  
A refuge in times of trouble.

Trouble, that word can be rendered: destruction, desperation or high cost.

The Lord is your hiding place in times of high cost. Lean heavily on His Covenant promises, and celebrate His Word to you.

Psalm 23:1  
The Lord (Jehovah Lord of Hosts) is my Shepherd  
I shall not want, be in lack, suffer need  
You prepared a table (Communion) before me, in  
The presence of (my defeated, paralyzed enemy),  
You anoint my head with oil (I am chosen, set apart, to rule)  
My cup runs over (with abundance)  
Goodness (of the Lord) and mercy (new every morning)  
Follow me all the days of my life  
And I will dwell in The House of the Lord forever  
(eternally secure in the family of faith, rest).

Psalm 37:3-4  
Trust in The Lord, and do good,  
Dwell in the land (of blessing and promise)  
And feed on His faithfulness (even when we are faithless)  
Delight yourself also in The Lord,  
And He will give you the desires of your heart.

Psalm 65:4  
Blessed is the man you choose,  
and cause to approach you,  
that he may dwell in your courts.  
We shall be satisfied with the goodness of your house,  
Of your Holy Temple.

Psalm 84:11 (NKJV)  
For the Lord God *is* a sun and shield;  
The Lord will give grace and glory;  
No good *thing* will He withhold  
From those who walk uprightly.

Wow, no good thing.

Proverbs 8:20-21 (NKJV)  
I traverse the way of righteousness,  
In the midst of the paths of justice,  
<sup>21</sup> That I may cause those who love me to inherit wealth,  
That I may fill their treasuries.

God wants His people blessed to overflow.

Proverbs 10:3  
The Lord will not allow the righteous soul to go hungry.

Proverbs 15:6  
In the house of the righteous is much treasure.

Proverbs 28:10  
...but the upright shall have good things in possession.  
28:20  
...a faithful man shall abound with blessings.  
28:25  
...but he who trusts in The Lord will be prospered.

Isaiah 1:19  
If you are willing and obedient,  
You shall eat the good (the best) of the land.

Isaiah 30:23 (NKJV)  
Then He will give the rain for your seed  
With which you sow the ground,  
And bread of the increase of the earth;  
It will be fat and plentiful.  
In that day your cattle will feed  
In large pastures.

God has big plans for you, stop thinking small, rest in His promises!

Isaiah 45:2-3 (AMP)  
I will go before you and level the mountains [to make the crooked places  
straight]; I will break in pieces the doors of bronze and cut asunder the bars of  
iron.  
<sup>3</sup> And I will give you the treasures of darkness and hidden riches of secret  
places, that you may know that it is I, the Lord, the God of Israel, Who calls  
you by your name.

Isaiah 48:17 (NAS)

Thus says the Lord, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel,  
"I am the Lord your God, who teaches you to profit,  
Who leads you in the way you should go.

Isaiah 55:11 (NAS)

So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth;  
It will not return to Me empty,  
Without accomplishing what I desire,  
And without succeeding *in the matter* for which I sent it.

Isaiah 58:11 (NAS)

"And the Lord will continually guide you,  
And satisfy your desire in scorched places,  
And give strength to your bones;  
And you will be like a watered garden,  
And like a spring of water whose waters do not fail.

Jeremiah 29:11 (AMP)

For I know the thoughts *and* plans that I have for you, says the Lord, thoughts  
*and* plans for welfare *and* peace and not for evil, to give you hope in your  
final outcome.

Joel 2:25-26 (NAS)

"Then I will make up to you for the years  
That the swarming locust has eaten,  
The creeping locust, the stripping locust and the gnawing locust,  
My great army which I sent among you.  
<sup>26</sup> "You will have plenty to eat and be satisfied  
And praise the name of the Lord your God,  
Who has dealt wondrously with you;  
Then My people will never be put to shame.

Haggai 2:8 (AMP)

The silver is Mine and the gold is Mine, says the Lord of hosts.

Matthew 6:33 (NAS)

But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be  
added to you.

Everything you have need of.

Matthew 7:11 (NAS)

If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give what is good to those who ask Him!

God knows how to give me good things!

Mark 10:28-30 (NAS)

Peter began to say to Him, "Behold, we have left everything and followed You." <sup>29</sup>Jesus said, "Truly I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or farms, for My sake and for the gospel's sake, <sup>30</sup>but that he will receive a hundred times as much now in the present age, houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and farms, along with persecutions; and in the age to come, eternal life.

A praise the Lord fits nicely here.

Luke 6:38 (NAS)

Give, and it will be given to you. They will pour into your lap a good measure—pressed down, shaken together, *and* running over. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return."

How big can you believe for?

Luke 12:32 (NAS)

Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has chosen gladly to give you the kingdom.

John 8:32 (NKJV)

And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

Free from fear, from lack, from distress, from \_\_\_\_\_.

John 10:10

I have come so that you might have life  
And experience life in more abundance.

John 16:23-24 (NKJV)

"And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. <sup>24</sup>Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.

He said full!

Acts 20:32 (NAS)

And now I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build *you* up and to give *you* the inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

The Word of your New Covenant, will build you up, and bring the release of your God given inheritance.

Romans 8:32 (NAS)

He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him over for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?

He means what He says, all things.

2 Corinthians 8:9 (NAS)

For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sake He became poor, so that you through His poverty might become rich.

Rich means rich.

Galatians 6:9 (NAS)

Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary.

If you have planted seed, your crop is on the way.

Ephesians 1:3 (NKJV)

Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ,

The word blessed is also translated, to prosper. Every blessing Heaven enjoys is laid up for you.

Ephesians 3:20 (NAS)

Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us,

God is not only able, He is willing too.

Philippians 4:19 (AMP)

And my God will liberally supply (fill to the full) your every need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

He will fill to the full.
